Our mission through Women to Women

- Bringing aid to women in the United States, or anywhere in the world, to help them become equal partners within their communities.
- Giving women a chance to improve life for themselves, their families, and their community.

Criteria for Gifts

- Business must be a new business.
- Education is to lead to a career or vocation.

An official **Women to Women** application must be completed and submitted.

An application must be signed by the Bishop in the Diocese in which the project or education is to take place.

An application must be signed by an officer of the Episcopal Church Women or the Mothers' Union from the diocese in which the project or education is to take place.

Women to Women funding is given only once for the same project or education.

The maximum amount of a **Women to Women** gift is \$5,000 for a project or \$1,000 for education.
